Chapter 7: Love in Action

In this chapter, we are reminded of what Jesus told his followers-"*I* want you to love one another as you have seen Me love." GUESS I'VE ALWAYS BEEN A MISSIONARY AT HEART AND THIS STARTED IN MY CHILDHOOD BEFORE I EVEN KNEW IT. OUR MOTHER USED TO HAVE MISSIONARIES INTO OUR HOME FOR MEALS AND

- OVERNIGHTS WHEN I WAS YOUNG, AND THESE PEOPLE AND THEIR STORIES MADE LASTING
- IMPRESSIONS ON ME. THEN THERE WAS CAMP, WHEN AGAIN, I WAS EXPOSED TO MISSIONARIES AND
- THEIR STORIES OF CARRYING JESUS' LOVE INTO ALL KINDS OF PLACES IN THE WORLD. ONE YEAR AT
- CAMP, WE WERE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO DEDICATE OUR LIVES INTO "FULL TIME CHRISTIAN
- SERVICE." I HAD RECEIVED CHRIST WHEN I WAS SEVEN YEARS OLD, SO THIS NOW WAS A FULLER
- GROWTH FOR ME, AND I RAISED MY HAND. I'M SURE NO ONE SAW THAT BUT GOD. I FELT SO
- WONDERFUL AFTER THAT, OF COURSE NEVER KNOWING WHERE GOD WOULD LEAD ME.
 - COLLEGE YEARS CAME, AND THE CALL WAS EVEN LOUDER. I PARTICIPATED WITH OTHERS IN
- STARTING A LITTLE NEIGHBORHOOD SUNDAY SCHOOL FOR POOR CHILDREN, AND WHEN
- MARRIAGE CAME, THE CALL CEASED TO GO AWAY. WESTON AND I WERE BOTH SCHOOL TEACHERS,
- BUT BOTH WERE INTERESTED IN MISSIONS. ONE DAY WE SENT IN AN APPLICATION TO THE
- PRESBYTERIAN BOARD OF WORLD MISSIONS SHOWING OUR INTEREST. SOME YEARS LATER, WE
- RECEIVED AN OPPORTUNITY TO GO TO BRAZIL TO A LITTLE INTERIOR SCHOOL TO TEACH
- MISSIONARIES' CHILDREN. WESTON HAD A GOOD TEACHING JOB, BUT BY THIS TIME WE HAD TWO
- SMALL CHILDREN, BECKY 5 YEARS AND DAVID 14 MONTHS. WE HAD NO MONEY TO CARRY OUT
- ALL THAT MUST BE DONE, SO IT WAS AN INNER STRUGGLE FOR MY HUSBAND ESPECIALLY, WHO BY
- THAT TIME WAS A SCHOOL PRINCIPAL. HE FINALLY YIELDED AND WORKED IT OUT IN HIS MIND, AND
- GOD WAS WORKING TOO, GATHERING SUPPORT FOR US AS WELL. IN AUGUST 1968, WE ARRIVED IN A
- DUSTY LITTLE TOWN CALLED CERES, BRAZIL WHERE THERE WAS A SCHOOL FOR MISSIONARIES'
- CHILDREN. THERE WE LABORED FOR THREE YEARS, AND WOULD HAVE GONE BACK, BUT THE
- MISSION BOARD WAS NOT PLACING ANY MORE MISSIONARIES AT THAT TIME.
 - SINCE THEN, THAT MISSIONARY HEART HAS REMAINED IN ME, WITH A SHORT TERM TRIP TO RUSSIA
- IN 1991 FOR THE MOSCOW PROJECT SINGING WITH A CHOIR OF 150 AS BACK-UP TO LARNELLE
- HARRIS AND HELPING TO DISTRIBUTE 1,000,000 RUSSIAN BIBLES. IN 1992, I WAS IN UKRAINE, TAKING
- WITH ME MY BELOVED SISTER, DEBBIE KELLEY. THERE WE SERVED IN STREET, HOSPITAL AND
- EVANGELISTIC MEETINGS AS MIMES, TELLING THE STORY OF JESUS AND HIS LOVE.
- NOW IN MY LATER YEARS, I CAN'T RUN ABOUT THE WORLD ANYMORE, BUT THE DRIVE TO
- CONTINUE TO TEACH PEOPLE ABOUT JESUS IS STILL IN ME. I'M SO AMAZED THAT THAT COMMITMENT
- AT CAMP SO MANY YEARS AGO WAS SO WONDERFULLY FULFILLED BY THE LORD WHO HAS HIS PLANS
 - FOR EACH OF US, AND HAS MADE MY LIFE SO FULL AND INTERESTING. HE IS FAITHFUL!
