The Book of Job raises these questions, as well as a number of others, and provides the believer with the proper lenses through which to view the difficult and painful circumstances we face in this sin-weary world. Far from being a hindrance to understanding the problem of suffering, the Book of Job shows us that the sovereignty of God is the only answer.

Beginning in September, Elder Stuart Pratt will lead the Adult Sunday School class in a study of the Book of Job. We will be using Eric Ortlund's, "Job: A 12-Week Study." 
After you get a book and have read it you will have the choice of 2 more dates to meet together to "review" the book:
